



September 3, 2023 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time



Hi, my name is Annika Maniego, and this month I had the opportunity to attend my 3rd World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal. I attended my first WYD in 2013 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil and my second WYD in 2016 in Krakow, Poland. Each WYD has been a beautifully, wildly different experience, and this one was no different. As one of the older pilgrims in the group, I was tasked with helping to chaperone the group, most of whom had never been to WYD. Due to the responsibilities of this role, I found myself much more attuned to the stresses of being a leader as opposed to the spiritual aspect of WYD. That is, until our final day of Catechesis. You may have read about my fellow pilgrims' experiences with this, but the beautiful part of our faith is not only the universality of it but also the personal journey each of us has to go through to end up in the same place.

Our final day of Catechesis consisted of talks from bishops and priests from around the world, along with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Maybe it was the pure exhaustion of only having 4 hours of sleep each of the prior five nights or the 4-6 mile walks everyday, but this day I was finally able to calm myself and be in the moment. I heard stories of the power of our faith, Penance, & forgiveness, and was truly moved by each of them. Between each of these stories the entire Church would sing in unison for praise and worship. While I used to attend Praise and Worship events monthly, it had been years since I had attended an event of this stature. However, even with the passage of time, in that church in Lisbon, Portugal, it felt as if time and geographical location ceased to exist. I let go and let God in for the first time in what felt like an eternity. I laid down my burdens and felt the Holy Spirit enter as I prayed in unison with nearly 1,000 pilgrims from around the globe.

I am so grateful to belong to the Holy Family community who has continued to support me as I have made my way from Baptism up to today. I am eternally thankful to each person who has supported us financially and spiritually, especially as I have been able to experience WYD three times now. I recognize the privilege of this and hope you know that you were in all of our prayers throughout the week of WYD and continue to be in mine. I would like to thank my fellow pilgrims for supporting me during the last two years of fundraisers & events and being on this pilgrimage as I navigated us through some tough situations. It was truly a joy to watch as you experienced your first WYD, and I hope this is not your last. Finally, I would like to give thanks, in a special way, to my parents. Thank you for the gift of Catholic education for 18 years, and thank you for paving the way for my faith to grow.




