

A few things to remember:

Bambinelli Sunday – December 17th

As we prepare for Christmas at Holy Family, we have many special traditions. The Church is decorated with Christmas trees, poinsettias, Christmas lights inside and out, as well as two manger scenes, inside and outside.

However, on the Third Sunday of Advent, our Church is filled with not just two, but many more baby Jesus figures for the Blessing of the Bambinelli.

This Tradition of the Blessing of the Bambinelli was first instituted by St. John Paul II. On the Third Sunday of Advent, the children of Rome are encouraged to bring the baby Jesus (Bambinelli) from each of their Nativity sets to St. Peter's Square.

This Advent tradition is a way for children to connect their Nativity scene at home to the celebration of Christmas here at Holy Family.

I invite ALL of our parishioners to bring their Baby Jesus Figurines, next Sunday for a special blessing at the 10:30 & 12noon Masses. The children of Holy Family Parish will also receive a special blessing at the 10:30 Mass and will receive a mini–Baby Jesus figurine to take with them.




