Dear Parishioners,

Father Costello, the vicar for Queens East, has asked that his letter be shared with the faithful of Deanery 5, to which Holy Family Parish belongs. Along with reading his letter, I would like to share with you the current pulse of Holy Family regarding the clergy and sacramental life of the parish.

As your pastor, I am the **ONLY priest** who is assigned to Holy Family Parish while remaining a high school chaplain in Brooklyn, which requires a weekly visit and other virtual responsibilities. Priests are beginning to take on more shared responsibilities among combined parishes and the diocese. We are incredibly blessed to enjoy the generosity of the other priests of Holy Family who assist me with the sacramental life:

Msgr. Furnari is our retired pastor and has no “official” responsibilities in the parish, but he is **VERY GENEROUS** with his time, remaining actively involved.

Msgr. Caserta is the retired pastor of the Parish of St. Bernadette, and like Msgr. Furnari has no “official” responsibilities to Holy Family Parish. He is active in his retirement, teaching at St. John’s University and doing retreat work and spiritual direction on a regular basis.

Fr. Ralph Edel is the full-time chaplain of St. Francis Prep and is willing to assist with a weekend Mass. Fr. Ralph is not assigned to Holy Family Parish.

Fr. James Kuroly is the Rector-President of Cathedral Prep. Fr. Kuroly assists at Holy Family when it fits his schedule. Typically, he will celebrate either the 7:30 am Mass or 5 pm Mass on Sunday. He only comes twice a month.

Fr. Patrick Griffin is a Vincentian priest at St. John’s University, and like the other priests, he is generous with his time to help cover Masses.

I appreciate their willingness to assist, and we are very lucky to have them, but at any time this could change.

Fr. Anthony Rosado is not assigned to Holy Family Parish but is on loan to us from the diocese and serves at the pleasure of the bishop.

Deacon Eugene Cassidy is on medical leave and is taking care of health.

The other part of the sacramental life falls upon me regarding baptisms, weddings, funerals, wake services, marriage prep, anointing calls, etc. If other commitments do arise, Msgr. Furnari and Msgr. Caserta are always willing to assist.

I share this with you because even though there is a **GREAT SPIRIT**, and we are a very healthy and strong parish in our deanery, we must always be ready and flexible for change, whether it’s to the sacramental life or a new model of parish life.

The purpose of Father Costello’s letter and Bishop Brennan’s letter on November 3rd is that we need to prepare for a possibly lower number of assigned priests. Eventually, (not now) adjusting the schedule of the Mass will take into consideration church capacity and streamline operations and ministries across the diocese.

Many of the pastors in Deanery 5 have expressed concern about a shortage in Mass attendance, especially after COVID-19. As you see in Father Costello's letter, this is a serious issue for some. For Holy Family, we have done a decent job of retaining attendance considering the challenges that face us: people moving, the rise in parishioners becoming homebound, and younger families just not attending church and seeing no need for it.

The REALITY is that there are challenges that face us in the future as Universal Church and as a parish community. Parish mergers or partnerships are not the complete solution, but it is a step in the right direction to begin to work together and address the immediate needs.

As your priest and pastor, and with many more years in service to the Church, I look at all these as new opportunities to strengthen ourselves and our Catholic faith, always relying on Jesus Christ, who is our FIRM FOUNDATION and HOPE! The Church TODAY is much different than what it was 30, 40, 50, or 60 years ago. I marvel at hearing stories of the past (packed churches, schools, seminaries, and an abundance of priests), but I LOVE the Church of TODAY... and whatever challenges, opportunities, mergers, and partnerships lie ahead in the Diocese of Brooklyn, we are in this together, always remaining true to the mission of the Church: *encountering Jesus, accompanying others, and living the joy of the Gospel.*

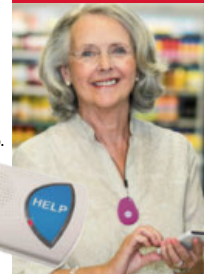
