



LENTEN REGULATIONS

Traditionally in the Catholic Church, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving.

The following are various Lenten regulations:

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday—These are days of

Fast & Abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive.

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence from Meat. All who are 14 and older are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something difficult) are recommended.


Prayer to St. Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church
