

World Youth Day Reflection from Francene Olegario

"Truthfully, I did not know what to expect from this year's World Youth Day pilgrimage and was skeptical as to how this experience would leave a significant impact on my life.

However, I am grateful to say that it was a profound experience that has led me to gain new perspectives and insights that I believe have deepened my understanding of my faith and my relationship with God as well as with those around me.

Personally, I had been struggling with my faith the older I became as the reality of the world seemed to become much more transparent as I matured. Constant reminders of corruption, greed, selfishness, bigotry, hatred, and death as well as personal hardships made it difficult to solidify what it meant to be a practicing Catholic amidst the messiness.

However, at the culmination of World Youth Day after we had trekked in the sweltering heat to the open field, it was to my surprise the most peaceful I had felt in a while. I remember for a moment just sitting and closing my eyes in the chaos reminding myself that Jesus had also experienced what it was like to be human. He too experienced hunger, fatigue, anger, betrayal, and grief and had witnessed horrors beyond our imagination under the rule of the Roman Empire. He was especially tortured and put to death for refusing to conform even if it meant saving His own life.

However, despite witnessing and experiencing all of this, He persistently displayed genuine acts of love and compassion towards ALL He came across. And so, even though I had felt fatigued, achy, and frustrated that day, I believe there was this peace I felt knowing that I was not alone in my struggles and that even though the world may be as bleak as it seems, we as humans have the ability to be loving and compassionate to ALL we come across.

As Pope Francis had said during World Youth Day, "There is room for EVERYONE in the Church," and I pray that even at times we as the youth feel discouraged, we remain steadfast in understanding what it means to share God's unconditional love as Jesus did. "




