The Point Reduction

Up to **four (4) points** will automatically be deducted from the total on your driver record, if you have incurred violations during the 18-month period prior to completing DDC. The point reduction could help you avoid a license suspension! However, it will *not* cancel a mandatory suspension or revocation, e.g. 3 speeding convictions within 18 months; nor will it cancel any action that is already being taken against a motorist's driving privileges.

The Point/Insurance Reduction Program

New York has long been recognized as one of the most progressive states in the area of highway safety programs. The **Point/Insurance Reduction Program** is offered to New York drivers as an incentive for their involvement in a driver improvement course. The goal is to achieve a significant reduction in the number of reportable accidents that occur on New York highways each year.

The National Safety Council, in cooperation with the Department of Motor Vehicles and your insurance company, is pleased to offer you a way to lower your insurance premiums, reduce your driver record violation points, and sharpen your driving skills.

What is The Defensive Driving Course?
