



March Hospitality Sunday will take place on March 24, 2024 which is Palm Sunday.




Prayer to St. Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church

Lenten Regulation and Events at Holy Family

Regulations: 14 and older are required to abstain totally from meat on Fridays of Lent. For those between the ages of 18 to 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

Events: Monday – Thursdays of Lent is Adoration & Confession 7pm-8pm. Fridays of Lent Stations of the Cross are prayed at 7pm. Wednesday March 6th is our 27th Lenten Soup Supper @ 6pm.

Easter Sacraments (RCIA)


